


Guitar - Timon Kellenberger:

2. General

PA:

Please provide professional systems only, no DIY. ©

The PA should be able to transmit loud and punchy pop-music in relation to venue and audience and amplify up to at least 100db(A) RMS distortion-free.

FOH / Engineers:

The band is NOT travelling with their own sound engineer.

We kindly request a FOH sound engineer to be present throughout the whole soundcheck and show.

The FOH mixing desk should be an up-to-date digital desk (Yamaha/Midas/Sound-craft/etc) or a similarly equipped analogue desk. It should be equipped with all common outboard gear (GEQ, compressors/gates for drums, compressors for bass & vocals, reverb-processors) or its digital equivalents. FOH mixing desk has to be able to provide phantom power.

Monitoring:

2 buses, 2 wedges.

Stage:

Two mic-stands and enough XLR cables should be provided by the venue. We're bringing our own mics.

A power outlet should be placed at the guitarist's position.

Light:

In reasonable relation to venue and audience. If there's someone willing and able to handle this, we'd be more than happy! ©

Backline:

This is an amp-free setup. No further backline needed.
